

RESOLUTION OF NECESSITY FOR A REPLACEMENT LEVY FOR CURRENT EXPENSES OF THE ASHTABULA COUNTY DISTRICT LIBRARY PURSUANT TO OHIO REVISED CODE §5705.192

The Board of County Commissioners of Ashtabula County, Ohio, introduced the following resolution and moved its passage:

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Ashtabula County District Library, Ashtabula County, Ohio ("Library"), has passed a resolution requesting this Board, as the taxing authority for said Library, to place the question of a replacement levy for current expenses of the Library on the ballot at the November 8, 2022 general election; and

WHEREAS, the Ashtabula County Auditor has certified that such tax will generate \$1,209,100.00 during the first year of collection, based on the current assessed valuation of the library district of the Library of \$1,018,189,400.00; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Ashtabula County Board of Commissioners, Ashtabula County, Ohio, two-thirds of all of the members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. The amount of taxes which may be raised within the ten-mill limitation by levies on the current tax duplicate will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the necessary requirements of the Library and it is necessary to levy a replacement tax in excess of such limitation for current expenses of the Library, which tax shall be levied on the entirety of the territory of the Ashtabula County Library District.

Section 2. The question of such tax levy shall be submitted to the electors of the library district of the Library, as established under R.C. Chapter 3375, at the election to be held therein on November 8, 2022.

Section 3. Such tax levy shall be for a term of ten (10) years and at a rate not exceeding 1.25 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to \$0.125 for each one hundred dollars of valuation.

Section 4. Such tax levy shall not be placed upon the tax list and duplicate for the current tax year, but shall be placed upon the tax list and duplicate in 2023, first due in calendar year 2024, if a majority of the electors voting thereon vote in favor thereof.

Section 5. This Board finds, determines and declares that the levy of the tax, if approved by the electors, is necessary to the proper furnishing and rendering of free public library services in the library district of the Library and for the residents of such library district.

Section 6. The Clerk of the Ashtabula County Board of Commissioners shall and is hereby directed to certify a copy of this resolution to the Board of Elections of Ashtabula County, Ohio, not later than August 10, 2022.

Section 7. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Board concerning and relating to the passage of this resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Board, and that all deliberations of this Board and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

COMMISSIONERS, ASHTABULA COUNTY, OHIO TO SUBMIT
TO THE ELECTORS OF THE LIBRARY DISTRICT OF THE
ASHTABULA COUNTY DISTRICT LIBRARY THE QUESTION OF
A REPLACEMENT OF AN EXISTING TAX LEVY FOR CURRENT
EXPENSES OF THE ASHTABULA COUNTY DISTRICT LIBRARY.

(R.C. Sections 5705.192)
Replacement of an Existing Tax Levy

WHEREAS, the Board is a board of library trustees appointed pursuant to Section 3375.22, Ohio Revised Code, and is a board of library trustees described in Section 3375.32, Ohio Revised Code; and

WHEREAS, the Board desires the Board of County Commissioners, Ashtabula County, Ohio to replace, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 5705.192, a tax levied under Section 5705.23, Ohio Revised Code, for current expenses; and

WHEREAS, the Ashtabula County Auditor has certified that the above-referenced tax will generate \$1,209,100.00 during the first year of collection, based on the current assessed valuation of the library district of the Library of \$1,018,189,400.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Ashtabula County District Library, a county district library of Ashtabula County, Ohio, two-thirds of all the members thereof concurring, that:

Section 1. It is hereby declared that the amount of taxes which may be raised within the ten-mill limitation by levies on the current tax duplicate will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the necessary requirements of the Library and that it is necessary to levy a replacement tax in excess of such limitation for current expenses of

the Library, replacing the 1.25 mill levy passed on November 5, 2013. Accordingly, the Board of County Commissioners, Ashtabula County, Ohio (the "Library Taxing Authority"), the taxing authority to whose jurisdiction the Board is subject, is hereby requested to submit to the electors of the library district of the Library, as established under R.C. Chapter 3375, at the general election to be held November 8, 2022, the question of a replacement of an existing tax for current expenses of the Library, which tax shall be levied on the entirety of the territory of the library district of the Library located in Ashtabula County, Ohio.

Section 2. This Board hereby requests the Board of County Commissioners of the Library Taxing Authority adopt a resolution under Section 5705.192, Ohio Revised Code, and other applicable provisions of law, to submit to the electors of the library district of the Library at an election to be held therein on November 8, 2022, the question of such replacement of an existing tax for current expenses of the Library.

Section 3. Such tax levy shall be for a ten (10) year term at a rate not exceeding 1.25 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to (\$.125) for each one hundred dollars of valuation.

Section 4. Such tax levy shall be not placed upon the current tax list and duplicate but shall be placed upon the tax list and duplicate in 2023, first due in calendar year 2024, if a majority of the electors voting thereon vote in favor thereof.¹

Section 5. The Board finds, determines and declares that the levy of the tax, if approved by the electors, is necessary to the proper furnishing and rendering of free public library services in the library district of the Library for the residents of such library district.

Section 6. The Fiscal Officer of the Board, acting on behalf of the Board, is hereby directed to certify a copy of this resolution to the Clerk of the Board of County Commissioners of the Library Taxing Authority.

Section 7. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Board concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Board, and that all deliberations of this Board and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.11, Ohio Revised Code.

1. On March 18, 2022, the taxing authority of the Ash Co. District Library (political subdivision name) certified a copy of its resolution or ordinance adopted March 16, 2022, requesting the county auditor to certify the current tax valuation of the subdivision and the amount of revenue that would be produced by 1.25 (.) mills, to levy a tax outside the 10-mill limitation for Current Expense purposes pursuant to Revised Code § 5705.19 A, to be placed on the ballot at the Nov. 8, 2022, election. Instructions

1. "Total tax valuation" includes the taxable value of all real property in the subdivision as indicated on the tax list most recently certified for collection and estimates of the taxable value of personal and public utility personal property for the first year the levy will be collected as set forth on the worksheets prescribed in conjunction with this form. If the subdivision is located in more than one county, the home county auditor (where the greatest taxable value of the subdivision is located) shall obtain the assistance of the other county auditors to establish the total tax valuation of the subdivision.
2. For purposes of this certification, "subdivision" includes any agency, board, commission or other authority authorized to request a taxing authority to submit a tax levy on its behalf.
3. "Levy type" includes the following: (1) additional, (2) renewal, (3) renewal with an increase, (4) renewal with a decrease, (5) replacement, (6) replacement with an increase and (7) replacement with a decrease levies.
4. Please file this certificate with the subdivision as soon as possible, so the taxing authority can pass a resolution to proceed not later than 90 days before the election.
