WHEREAS, in accordance with Ohio Revised Code Section 301.27, on August 2, 2016 by Resolution 2016-204 the Ashtabula County Board of Commissioners established a Credit Card Usage policy; and

WHEREAS, said policy being amended on August 30, 2017 by Resolution No. 2017-246; and

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of this Board of Commissioners that the following office has requested an increase in its credit card limit, as follows:

WHEREAS, this board hereby authorizes the increase to the credit card limit for the Ashtabula County Children Services Board from \$10,000 to \$13,750 on a temporary basis through December 31, 2022; and

WHEREAS, effective January 1, 2023 the credit card limit will revert back to \$10,000; now

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, By the Board of Commissioners of Ashtabula County, Ohio, in accordance with the established Credit Card Policy the Ashtabula County Children Services Board's credit card limit is increased from \$10,000 to \$13,750 on a temporary basis through December 31, 2022.
