

**RESOLUTION HOLDING A PUBLIC HEARING ON ASHTABULA COUNTY'S PY2022 APPLICATION TO THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF DEVELOPMENT FOR COMMUNITY HOUSING IMPACT AND PRESERVATION LEAD ABATEMENT PROGRAM (CHIP-LAP) GRANT BY THE COMMUNITY SERVICES & PLANNING DEPT.**

WHEREAS, This being the date and time set for the public hearing on the Ashtabula County's **Community Housing Impact and Preservation Lead Abatement Program (CHIP-LAP) Grant** application for PY2022; and

WHEREAS, Ashtabula County Department of Community Services & Planning personnel will explain the eligibility requirements, filing requirements, grant period, proposed activities, proposed budget and outcomes of the PY 2022 **Community Housing Impact and Preservation Lead Abatement Program (CHIP-LAP) Grant** Program application; and

WHEREAS, the following was presented:

Ohio Department of Development (Development) has partnered with Ohio Department of Health (ODH) to leverage funding to current Community Housing Impact and Preservation (CHIP) Programs, to eliminate lead-based paint hazards in homes currently receiving CHIP Program assistance.

CHIP-LAP funds will be made available on a competitive basis to current CHIP Program grantees (i.e., grantees who have been awarded PY 2020, PY 2021, or PY 2022 CHIP grants). Funds will be awarded for activity costs, including:

- Lead Risk Assessment,
- Lead Abatement Specification Preparation,
- Tenant Relocation Services,
- Lead Abatement Specification line items completed,
- Lead Abatement Site-Inspections, and
- Lead Clearance Report.

The total cost for all lead hazard control work must be under the project limit of \$30,000 per unit. Any projects over these amounts will require prior written approval from Development. All funds requested and awarded must be expended by the grantee. The grant period for CHIP-LAP funds will be until April 30, 2024.

Applications will be submitted in OCEAN as a new CHIP Application Request. Applications to request CHIP-LAP supplemental and equipment grant funds must be submitted by 11:59 p.m. on October 12, 2022.

As lead agency Ashtabula County intends to submit an application to the Ohio Development Services Agency for the PY 2022 CHIP-LAP grant in the amount of \$150,000.00. The application is being prepared by the Department of Community Services & Planning.

WHEREAS, Comments from the public were offered as follows:

Amy Coursen thanked the Board of Commissioners for partnering with the city in this grant application. The program includes the whole county of Ashtabula.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, By the Board of Commissioners of Ashtabula County, Ohio, that the public hearing held on the proposed grant application to the Ohio Department of Development for the PY 2022 **Community Housing Impact and Preservation Lead Abatement Program (CHIP-LAP)** funds is hereby adjourned.
