

Dear Judge Specht,

Please accept this letter as formal notification that the *Ashtabula County Court Eastern Division Drug-Veterans Treatment Court* has been awarded final certification pursuant to Sup. R. 36.26. On August 12, 2022, the Commission on Specialized Dockets voted in favor of this final certification effective August 12, 2022 through December 31, 2024.

In order to maintain certification of a specialized docket issued by the Supreme Court pursuant to Sup. R. 36.26, the court operating the specialized docket shall do both of the following:

(A) Every three years after receipt of certification or within six months after a change in the judge assigned to the session, whichever occurs first, successfully recomplete the certification application process pursuant to Sup. R. 36.21 through 36.26, provided the Specialized Dockets Section of the Supreme Court of Ohio may abbreviate the first certification period to allow for rotating certification periods among the courts and divisions.

(B) Notify the section of any changes to the procedures of or the documents or treatment providers used by the section in the specialized docket.
