

**RESOLUTION DECLARING AN EMERGENCY TO INSTALL GENERATOR AT THE BOARD OF ELECTIONS AND ACCEPTING QUOTE WITH B.S.E. ELECTRICAL CONTRACTORS, INC. FOR INSTALLATION**

WHEREAS, the Board of Elections has informed this Board that a real and present emergency exists with the lack of an emergency generator at the Board of Elections, due to the potential of a power outage affecting the ability of the public to vote in upcoming elections; and

WHEREAS, it is known that in 2020 there was a power outage that resulted in the closure of the building where early voting was occurring; and

WHEREAS, the situation has been reviewed and it is found that the immediate installation of a generator would ensure the voting process would be uninterrupted in the event of a power outage; and

WHEREAS, the costs of the installation of the generator is anticipated to be approximately \$54,206.00; and

WHEREAS, an attempt was made to acquire 3 quotes, however only one offeror submitted a proposal and the records shall be maintained of the received proposal and the attempt to receive quotes from the 2 other firms, for one year after the contract is awarded; and

WHEREAS, B.S.E. Electrical Contractors, Inc. who can perform the installation and is qualified to perform the work as the only firm to submit a quote; and

WHEREAS, the quote from B.S.E. Electrical Contractors, Inc. is accepted for the installation of the generator in the amount of \$54,206.00; now

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, By the Board of Commissioners of Ashtabula County that pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 307.86(A), an emergency is declared for the installation of the generator at the Board of Elections to allow for uninterrupted voting at a cost of \$54,206.00.

**Board of Elections Generator Project**

- 1. Installation of the concrete base pad per specs. With double matting of rebar. This includes the excavation, saw cutting of the asphalt, framing, pouring of concrete and finish.**
- 2. Excavation of dirt and concrete for the new power from the pole to the new Unistrut rack/ disconnects and meter.**
- 3. Rerouting the underground main feeder conduit. Installing the new 600 mcm wire up the pole into the new 400 amp meter device. ALL WIRE IS COPPER – per 2-f of the general specs.**
- 4. All lugs, crimps, connectors. Fittings, PVC, fuses, supports, etc. provided.**
- 5. Panels/disconnects will be Sq. D heavy duty.**
- 6. All inside work from and to MDP to panels are included.**
- 7. The generator being quoted is a Kohler. All of the specs. Are attached. The quote being supplied by BSE includes the State of Ohio – Fire Marshalls tank test with documentation. It will also include a load bank test with documentation.**
- 8. Buckeye Power Sales has included a start up at no additional charge unless the start up has to be done after hours.**
- 9. Rework meter socket on the building to and retro fit into a sealed junction box. This will include splicing the wires with compression connectors and sealed with shrink tubing.**
- 10. Thomas Fence is the fence supplier. Their quote has been assumed to be prevailing wage. Should this change, their price can be reduced by \$525.00.**

- 11. The price for this installation does not cover any First Energy cost to disconnect the power and reconnect during the shutdown.***
- 12. Should this job not be prevailing wage BSE will deduct \$700.00.***
- 13. BSE will provide all barriers for safety.***
- 14. BSE will provide all insurance, BWC and any necessary forms required.***

***Total installed price is \$54,206.00***
