Bidders are advised that HB 308 rules apply. Contractors or suppliers shall furnish MSDS sheets for any hazardous substance brought onto county property or a county job site.

All bidders are required to furnish MSDS information and lab test results complying with 2023 ODOT Spec. 703, with absorption percentage noted.

All #67 size aggregate shall meet the gradation specifications of Table 703.01 (ODOT 2023 CMS) and additionally have a washed gradation value of 1.5% maximum for passing a No. 200 (75 µm) sieve at the point of delivery

All #8 size aggregate shall meet the specifications of 422.02 (ODOT 2023 CMS) and additionally have a washed gradation value of 1.5% maximum for passing a No. 200 (75 µm) sieve at the point of delivery.

If the supplier is unable to furnish the quantity of stone at schedules set by the County Engineer, or is unable to furnish material meeting the specifications, the County reserves the right to purchase material from other sources.

Quantities stated are based on the intended use and are to be considered up to, but not exceeding. No substitution or extra material is to be furnished without proper authorization.

All quotations should include FOB Ashtabula County Highway Department, Jefferson, Ohio, and price at supply point. All quotations should state point of origin.

Successful bidders will be requested to furnish samples before awarding a contract.

Bidders may submit bids for one or all sizes listed.

The County will award a contract for each lot based on lowest and best meeting specifications.

All liquid asphalt must meet ODOT specification 702.04; provide Emulsified Asphalt according to AASHTO M 140 or AASHTO M 208.

The bidder must state free unloading time and demurrage charges.

The award of this bid is contingent upon the supplier furnishing material in a timely manner. If at any time material is furnished that does not work properly with the type of aggregate available, or fails to meet performance criteria set by the engineer, the supplier shall be notified immediately. If any requested corrections are not made to the next lot delivered, Ashtabula County will have cause to terminate the contract and choose an alternate supplier. If any surface treatment fails, and it is determined that the asphalt product is the causative factor, the supplier will pick up any unused portion at their own expenses and shall reimburse the county for the value of the product. Additionally, the supplier shall reimburse the county for all material used, labor and machine costs where faulty asphalt is determined to be a causative factor.

The bidder shall complete the "bid sheet for liquid asphalt emulsion" as provided.
