WHEREAS, the Ashtabula County Commissioners wish to apply for \$300,000 to ARC funding for the improvements to the Lenox New Lyme Waterline Extension, Phase 2- Jefferson Booster Station Replacement Project; and

WHEREAS, the Ashtabula County Department of Environmental Services will commit the local share of \$880,000, 74.6% of the total project cost of \$1,180,000; and

WHEREAS, the infrastructure improvement herein above described is considered to be a priority need for the community and is a qualified project under the ARC; and

WHEREAS, It is the desire of the Board to designate an official to sign and submit this application and to execute contracts in connection with said application; now

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by Ashtabula County Commissioners:

Section 1: Douglas Starkey, Director of the Ashtabula County Department of Environmental Services Department, is hereby authorized to apply to the ARC for funds as described above.

Section 2: The President of the Board of Ashtabula County Commissioners, is authorized to enter into any agreements as may be necessary and appropriate for obtaining this financial assistance.
