

RESOLUTION ALOCATING CORONAVIRUS STATE AND LOCAL FISCAL FUNDS UNDER THE AMERICAN PROTECTIONS ACTS (ARPA) TO VARIOUS AGENCIES FOR VARIOUS PURPOSES

WHEREAS, the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) of 2021 was signed into law on March 11, 2021, to provide additional relief to address the continued impact of COVID-19 on the economy, public health, state and local governments, individuals and businesses; and

WHEREAS, Section 9901 of ARPA amended Title VI of the Social Security Act to add section 603, which establishes the Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Fund (CLFRF); and

WHEREAS, The Ashtabula County Board of Commissioners created a separate Local Fiscal Recovery Fund per Resolution 2021-35FINA adopted on June 1, 2021, for the purpose of receiving ARPA monies and to track allocations and expenditures consistent with the requirements of ARPA; and

WHEREAS, all Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Funds under the American protections Act (ARPA) must be allocated by December 31, 2024 and appropriated by December 31, 2026; and

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Board of County Commissioners of Ashtabula County hereby resolves that the remaining balance of \$935,000 will be allocated as follows:

- 1) ASHTABULA COUNTY Clerk of courts in the amount of \$100,000.00 for additional costs related to the Courtview 3 Software and Implementation Service Project for the purpose of preventing and mitigating the Covid 19 pandemic.
- 2) ASHTABULA COUNTY Department of Environmental Services in the amount of \$150,000.00 for the construction of the Rome Township Bulk Water Station; the purchase of a generator for the AshCraft Wastewater Treatment Plant; the purchase of a generator for the North Beach Booster Station and the purchase of pro-tech SCADA connection for such generators for the purpose of making necessary investments in water and sewer infrastructure.
- 3) ASHTABULA COUNTY Sheriff's Department in the amount of \$135,000.00 for payroll, covered benefit and other costs associated with programs or services to support the public sector workforce by increasing the number of its budgeted full-time equivalent positions by up to the difference between the number of its budgeted full-time equivalent employees on January 27, 2020, multiplied by 1.075, and the number of its budgeted full-time equivalent employees on March 3, 2021, provided that funds shall only be used for additional budgeted full-time equivalent employees above the recipient's number of budgeted full-time equivalent employees as of March 3, 2021.
- 4) ASHTABULA COUNTY Crime Enforcement Agency of Ashtabula County in the amount of \$500,000.00 for operations related to reducing gun violence resulting the Covid 19 public health emergency.

This resolution shall be in full force and effect from and immediately upon its adoption.
