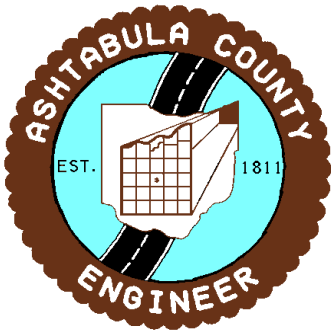

2024 ANNUAL REPORT

ASHTABULA COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE

The following report highlights the accomplishments of the Engineer’s Office and Highway Department during 2024. I remain committed to the mission of providing residents of Ashtabula County with a safe and efficient county highway system.”

The Harpersfield Covered Bridge rehabilitation project was completed in 2024 at a total cost of \$6.25M. Ending a multi-year effort by our staff and Union Industrial Contractors of Ashtabula. UIC, also completed a 69’ superstructure widening/replacement over the West Branch of the Ashtabula River in Pierpont. This contract was 100% Federally funded at \$767K.

The Highway Department constructed two 20’ steel beam structures, complete with new abutments. They widened another 20’ steel beam structure to 28’ to enhance safety. Two more 16’ precast box structures were built and installed at 32’ wide, which provides a greatly improved crossing.

The rehabilitation of Footville Richmond Rd. from the Rock Creek Village Line to SR 534 was finished by Ronyak Bros. Paving, Inc. After the Highway Department prepared the roadway by doing necessary drainage improvements, Ronyak cracked and seated the old concrete road, then overlaid the entirety with 4.5” of asphalt. Cost for the project was \$1.875M with \$1.65M contracted to Ronyak.
