

RESOLUTION RECEIVING NATIONAL OPIOIDS TRUST WALMART AND KROGER'S SHARE OF THE OPIOID SETTLEMENT AND DEPOSITING INTO THE 2004 OPIOID SETTLEMENT FUND

WHEREAS, Ashtabula County is a Local Government that has adopted and approved the OneOhio Memorandum of Understanding which establishes a mechanism to disburse settlement proceeds from the opioid litigation into Ohio's communities to help abate the opioid crisis, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the terms of the Memorandum, 30% of the settlement proceeds will be paid directly to local governments, including Ashtabula County, for approved purposes as delineated by the Memorandum, and

WHEREAS, The Ashtabula County Board of Commissioners is in receipt of settlement funds from National Opioids Trust Walmart Payment in the amount of \$1,382.18, Kroger's payment 1 in the amount of \$23,221.47 and Kroger's payment 2 in the amount of \$20,817.40 for a total of \$45,421.05; now

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Ashtabula County Board of Commissioners hereby receives and deposits said funds for the total amount of \$45,421.05 received from the local government share of the Opioid Settlement, into the 2004 Opioid Settlement Fund.


