

RESOLUTION TRANSFERRING FUNDS FROM THE 2004 OPIOID SETTLEMENT FUND AND DESIGNATING SAID FUNDS TO THE GENERAL FUND 1001

WHEREAS, Ashtabula County is a Local Government that has adopted and approved the OneOhio Memorandum of Understanding which establishes a mechanism to disburse settlement proceeds from the opioid litigation into Ohio's communities to help abate the opioid crisis, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the terms of the Memorandum, 30% of the settlement proceeds will be paid directly to local governments, including Ashtabula County, for approved purposes as delineated by the Memorandum, and

WHEREAS, The Ashtabula County Prosecutor's Office is comprised of assistant prosecutors and staff who work under the direction of the Prosecutor; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners hereby designates \$75,000 from fund 2004 to 1001 to fund an Assistant Prosecutor's salary prosecuting drug crimes; now

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Ashtabula County Board of Commissioners hereby designates the funds received from the local government share of the Opioid Settlement to the General Fund, as outlined above.
