

**RESOLUTION TRANSFERRING FUNDS FROM THE 2004 OPIOID SETTLEMENT FUND AND DESIGNATING SAID FUNDS TO THE GENERAL FUND 2107**

WHEREAS, Ashtabula County is a Local Government that has adopted and approved the OneOhio Memorandum of Understanding which establishes a mechanism to disburse settlement proceeds from the opioid litigation into Ohio's communities to help abate the opioid crisis, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the terms of the Memorandum, 30% of the settlement proceeds will be paid directly to local governments, including Ashtabula County, for approved purposes as delineated by the Memorandum, and

WHEREAS, The Ashtabula County Courts- Western Division has requested \$5,000.00 to assist with probation electronic release services- specifically GPS Monitoring Equipment; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners hereby designates \$5,000.00 from fund 2004 to 2107 to fund the probation electronic release services relating to substance abuse/mental health for the Ashtabula County Courts- Western Division; now

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Ashtabula County Board of Commissioners hereby designates the funds received from the local government share of the Opioid Settlement to the General Fund, as outlined above.
