

RESOLUTION TRANSFERRING FUNDS FROM THE 2004 OPIOID SETTLEMENT FUND AND DESIGNATING SAID FUNDS TO THE GENERAL FUND 1001

WHEREAS, Ashtabula County is a Local Government that has adopted and approved the OneOhio Memorandum of Understanding which establishes a mechanism to disburse settlement proceeds from the opioid litigation into Ohio's communities to help abate the opioid crisis, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the terms of the Memorandum, 30% of the settlement proceeds will be paid directly to local governments, including Ashtabula County, for approved purposes as delineated by the Memorandum, and

WHEREAS, The Ashtabula County Sheriff's Office is a law enforcement agency, working in collaboration to address the community supply and demand reduction strategies including criminal interdiction efforts relating to the opioid epidemic throughout Ashtabula County; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners hereby designates \$129,787.00 from fund 2004 to 1001 for the Ashtabula County Sheriff's Office; now

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Ashtabula County Board of Commissioners hereby designates the funds received from the local government share of the Opioid Settlement to the General Fund, as outlined above.
