WHEREAS, pursuant to the terms of the Memorandum, 30% of the settlement proceeds will be paid directly to local governments, including Ashtabula County, for approved purposes as delineated by the Memorandum, and

WHEREAS, The Ashtabula County Board of Commissioners is in receipt of the following settlement funds:

- Manufacturers & Traders Trust Co.- Distributor Payment 6 for \$85,823.04

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Ashtabula County Board of Commissioners hereby receives and deposits said funds for the total amount of \$85,823.04 received from the local government share of the Opioid Settlement, into the 2004 Opioid Settlement Fund.
