WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Section 309.09(C) allows the Board of County Commissioners to employ an attorney other than the prosecuting attorney of the county, without the authorization of the court of common pleas, for a particular matter or on an annual basis, to represent the board in its official capacity and to advise it on legal matters; and

WHEREAS, this Ashtabula County Board of Commissioners authorizes Bricker and Eckler as outside counsel in order to advise the Board as bond counsel and related matters on an annual basis for calendar year 2021, at a cost not to exceed the total annual compensation of the prosecuting attorney; now

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, By order of the Board of Commissioners of Ashtabula County, the services of Bricker and Eckler shall be retained as bond counsel and related matters on an annual basis for calendar year 2021, at a cost not to exceed the total annual compensation of the prosecuting attorney. The cost of same shall be borne by the Ashtabula County Board of Commissioners.
