

Each bid shall contain the full name of each person or company submitting a bid and shall be accompanied by a bond or a certified check, cashiers check or money order drawn on a solvent bank or savings and loan association in the amount of 5% of the total bid as security that if a bid is accepted delivery is assured.

Bidders are advised that HB 308 rules apply. Contractors or suppliers shall furnish MSDS sheets for any hazardous substance brought onto county property or a county job site.

Each bid must be in a sealed envelope and the outside thereof properly marked with the Quotation Number, Date and Time of the bid opening.

The purpose of this specification is to describe an acceptable traffic zone marking paint to be used for pavement markings and centerline striping as follows:

Traffic Paint, Type 1, fast dry, water-based 100% acrylic type

6655 Gallons Yellow
1540 Gallons White

The Ashtabula County Engineer reserves the right to inspect and test any or all of the material being bid, and ask for samples for testing to prove any characteristics which may be in question.

The Ashtabula County Engineer reserves the right to accept a material that does not comply with these Specifications, when such acceptance is in the best interest of the Ashtabula County Engineer and Highway Department.

REQUIREMENTS AND SPECIFICATIONS

INTENT

It is the intent of this bid to establish pricing for white and yellow ready-mixed traffic paint suitable for marking various types of pavement. The manufacturer shall formulate the paint in such a manner as to meet the requirements of this specification.

SPECIFICATIONS FOR TRAFFIC MARKING PAINT:

Specifications shown herein are incorporated into this invitation and made a part thereof are found in the 2019 Ohio Department of Transportation Construction and Materials Specifications Pavement Marking Items 640 and 740 including any and all revisions applicable.

FINISH PAINT

The paint shall be a suitable binder for glass beads on pavement exposed to traffic. It shall not deteriorate in storage, within nine months after date of receipt, to the extent that it cannot be readily broken up with a paddle to a smooth uniform paint capable of easy application by spray. The paint shall not bleed or discolor when sprayed on bituminous surfaces.

SAFETY DATA SHEETS

The Bidder is required to submit with their bid, material manufacturers product data sheet, and MSDS sheets for the product(s) being bid. Should the bidder fail to submit this data, their bid will not be considered.

CONTAINER MARKINGS AND WEIGHT REQUIREMENTS

The marking material shall be delivered in containers which are clearly marked to indicate the number of liters (gallons), weight or size of material, material color, batch

number or other similar manufacturer's identification, date of production and the company name and location.

FREE ON BOARD (F.O.B.) DESTINATION

DELIVERY

Delivery shall be made within 30 calendar days upon written or verbal notification of a valid purchase order. It is Ashtabula County Highway Department's preference to have the product delivered on pallets, to be unloaded from an open flatbed trailer.

DELIVERY HOURS

All deliveries shall be made between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. Monday through Friday not including holidays, unless special permission is granted by the Ashtabula County Highway Department to temporarily waive or adjust this requirement.

NOTICE OF DELIVERY

The vendor shall notify the Ashtabula County Highway Department 24 hours prior to making delivery.
